Dear Mr. Alcamo:

Monroe County has reviewed the Proposed Plan for the Record of Decision for the Lemon Lane Landfill, Proposed Water Overflow Treatment of Creek Cleanup. We agree with the USEPA and IDEM proposed cleanup for Operable Unit 2 (OU2)– Ground Water and Operable Unit #3 (OU3)– Sediment and Soil, with Modifications A and B at this site in Monroe County, Indiana.

Monroe County believes that the preferred Alternative 3 with Modifications A and B for OU2 and the OU3 remedial actions would be protective of local human health and our environment. The treatment of storm water overflow from the existing storage tanks and digging up and disposing of contaminated mud and soil are necessary and reasonable measures to reduce the levels of PCBs flowing into nearby Clear Creek.

Monroe County looks forward to working with USEPA and IDEM when this plan is implemented.
